NURSE'S NOTES

Children entering Kindergarten next year must have all the required immunizations and have had a physical within 12 months of starting Kindergarten. Also, all students going into 6th grade next year must have the required Tdap booster and have it to the school nurse prior to the start of the next school.

LUKE 24:35-48

This Gospel reading tells us of another appearance of the Risen Jesus to His apostles. What is made abundantly clear is that the Risen Jesus still had His physical body! It had been changed but is still was the same body that had been crucified. The Jewish understanding of the human person was that the body was essential to the person; it wasn't just a vessel for it. This belief in the unity of the human person—body and soul—is what is reflected in this Gospel. Jesus wanted His disciples to touch Him so that they would know that he wasn't a ghost. He also shared a meal with them—real bodies eat real food! Our faith includes a firm belief in the resurrection of the body; it's included in the Creed. This is a difficult but awesome teaching. Since we also have the same Spirit within us that raised Jesus from the dead, our mortal bodies will also be given life on the last day!

The office will be closed on all school Fridays from 8:25AM until @ 9:15AM so that all Academy staff may attend Mass. If your child is going to arrive during this timeframe please escort him/ her to the church and sign them in with either Mrs. Guichard or Mrs. Chicklo, who will be in the rear of the sanctuary.
